I'm writing to trusted friends to ask your help in finding a candidate to fill an important position here in Champaign County. Recently, our County Board terminated our County Supervisor of Assessments. The position will be filled by our County Board, which has a Democratic majority (in theory, at least). Our County Board Chairman has asked me to send this e-mail.

The previous SoA was the first Democrat ever to hold the position here in Champaign County. The opposition he faced was largely partisan, although a small number of Dems joined the GOP mob in fighting to have him removed. County Board leadership is hoping to find someone who was not involved in that controversy to fill the vacancy. Unfortunately, all of the local candidates (both D and R) were among the group who fought so hard to see the outgoing SoA fired, which is why we're looking outside Champaign County for a candidate with "clean hands".

I've attached a Word file listing the duties and qualifications for the Supervisor of Assessments. The annual salary is currently set at \$61,000. A qualified candidate must pass a Supervisor of Assessments exam, and an opportunity to do so will be offered here on July 10 for anyone who has not yet done so. This is a great opportunity for anyone in the assessment field willing to work here in Urbana.
