

**OBJECTOR'S PETITION TO THE PETITION FOR NOMINATION FILED BY
MICHAEL HENLEY**

1. I, Matthew Peek, hereby object to the Petition for Nomination filed by Michael Henley purportedly for the At-Large Council full term election in the City of Champaign.

2. I, Matthew Peek, reside at 1739 West Haven Drive, Champaign, Illinois.

3. I, Matthew Peek, object to said Petition for Nomination on the following grounds:

a. That on said petition the petition stated the voters were petitioning that Michael Henley shall be a non-partisan candidate for nomination "...to the office hereinafter specified, in the political division aforesaid, to be voted for at the At-Large Council election...". There is no such event known as "At-Large Council election" and therefore the election authorities would have no way of knowing whether the voters were petitioning to have Michael Henley placed on the ballot at a consolidated primary, a general election or a special election.

b. That the Petition for Nomination failed to specify whether the voters were petitioning that Michael Henley shall be a non-partisan candidate for City of Champaign elections, School Board elections, Champaign County elections or the elections of any other political subdivision in that the petition failed to specify the unit of government for or in which the office related.

c. That each of the ten pages of Petition for Nomination which were filed bear a changed date for the date of the election, namely the date of April 17, 2007 is crossed out and the date 02/27/07 is inserted. That it strains credulity to assume that the petition appeared with that changed date prior to being signed by the voters because had this been an error that was caught prior to any voters signing the Petition for Nomination it is highly likely that the error would not have occurred on all ten pages of the Petition for Nomination which were all circulated by Michael Henley.


d. That the pages of the Petition for Nomination were not "neatly fastened together in book form, by placing the sheets in a pile and fastening them together at one edge in a secure and suitable manner" as is required by 10 ILCS 5/10-4. Rather, it is the understanding of the objector that the pages were filed loosely and that a paperclip was used to bind the loyalty oath to the statement of candidacy but not even a paperclip was used to bind the various pages of the Petition for Nomination together.

4. The interest of the objector is to assure the continued integrity of the petition package submitted to the electoral official and to prevent tampering. The interest of the objector is also to have reasonable assurance that the voters who placed their signatures on said Petition for Nomination knew that they pertained to a consolidated primary election for the City of Champaign (as opposed to the County Board, the School Board, or some other elected body).


5. The relief that is requested of the electoral board by this objector is that the Petition for Nomination be declared to be invalid, that it be stricken, and that the name of Michael Henley not appear on the printed ballot for the consolidated primary election to be held February 27, 2007 nor for the election to be held April 17, 2007.
